<b>Use this form for one source only!</b>	<b>Your notes go here. Put one note per cell.</b> Use a <i>summary</i> (shorten what you find), a <i>paraphrase</i> (put what you don't understand into your own words to make it easy to understand), a <i>direct quotation</i> /passage from the source (along with who said it, who that person is, when he/she said it and why). Also, record the page number for later, when you cite the note in your document.	<b>Write your ideas:</b> Why is this important? How will you use this information? How does this information relate to what you already know?  Each annotation below will correspond directly with the note in the cell to the left.
